Two men reunite after eight years of living apart in this romantic drama. This movie portrays the **Japanese** LGBTQ+ community's lives and struggles in the modern world: with a courtroom drama fighting for child custody and gay couple's rights, the reforming of traditional family structures and societial values, parental pressure on children, and the harsh conditions for single mothers.

Director Imaizumi Rikiya an emotional presents and touching film, which also features comedic scenes of romantic and life family slice of moments. But most of all. is honest an and sensitive portrayal contemporary LGBTQ+ life in Japan.

The social and emotional struggles of the protagonists are understandable and touching for any international audience member of any identity or sexuality.
