


MEXT Scholarship



The Government of Japan is offering Luxembourgish nationals the opportunity to pursue their university or post-graduate studies in Japan from 2026. It is called the “MEXT Scholarship”.

*MEXT - Ministry of Education, Sports, Science and Technology

The scholarship includes an allowance to cover costs for such as tuition fee at universities, living expenses (fixed amount) and travel expenses. The scholarship is paid for the duration of your studies.

1. University Scholarship (Bachelor)

Who can apply?

The scholarship is available to any citizens of Luxembourgish nationality who must have completed, or are about to complete upon entrance, secondary school.

How does the application process work?

1. Please submit the documents required for your application to the Embassy (**Application deadline: Friday 6 June 2025**).
2. During June : Documents screening by the Embassy
3. One day or two days between 23rd June and 15th July : Interview and written tests at the Embassy of Japan in Luxembourg
4. After July : Second screening by MEXT.

At each stage, you will be informed of the result, indicating whether you are eligible for the next step.

2. Post-graduate scholarship (Master & PhD)

Who can apply?

The post-graduate scholarship is open to all university graduates of Luxembourgish nationality. They must have completed, or are about to complete upon entrance, a previous degree of the course they wish to apply for.

Luxembourg has always been able to send one person to study in Japan each year.

How does the application process work?

1. Please submit the documents required for your application to the Embassy (**Application deadline: Friday 6 June 2025**).
2. During June : Documents screening by the Embassy
3. One day or two days between 23rd June and 15th July : Interview and written tests at the Embassy of Japan in Luxembourg
4. After July : Second screening by MEXT.

At each stage, you will be informed of the result, indicating whether you are eligible for the next step.

What fields of study are eligible?

Applicants must apply for the field of study in which they specialised at university or for a similar field.
