Information relevant to Tohoku district - off the Pacific Ocean Earthquake

1. Japanese Government and relevant private sector tightly coordinate to tackle the troubles in Fukushima Daiichi and Daini nuclear power plants.

2. In this regard, we notice that some mass media diffuse wrong information lacking factual and rational basis.

The Prime Minister Mr. Kan and Chief Cabinet Secretary Mr. Edano are holding regular briefings; the Japanese Government is offering you correct and latest information prepared by the Cabinet, the Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency, the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as well as the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The information is available in English (partly in Chinese and Korean as well).

3. We recommend you to collect up-to-date information from reliable websites including the followings, for the situation surrounding the nuclear power plants caused by Tohoku district – off the Pacific Ocean Earthquake is still fluid.
